"Senior" is any person over 65 years of age with valid ID.

Advance ticket purchases are not available. All ticket sales are on the day of the event.

Location: The Downers Grove South Campus is located 1 mile east of I-355 on 63rd Street. I-294 to I-290 West is the best option for travel from Wisconsin or Indiana and Chicago South. I-80 or I-88 to I-355 north is the choice from the southwest suburbs or western Illinois. The campus address is: 1436 Norfolk Street, Downers Grove, IL 60516.

Seating: Doors open 1 hour before the 1st band performs. Grandstand seating is on a first come, first served basis in the West stands. Wristbands will be checked upon entering the West stands. Handicap seating is available on the ground level (track). Seating for band member chaperones and pit crews wishing to sit in the West stands will be expected to purchase a wrist band. Seat cushions and chair backs are allowed.

Recordings: Bands participating in public performances are required to comply with copyright laws in regards to performance and/or arrangement of copyrighted music, visual images, and other materials, as well as the use of copyrighted audio or spoken text, and the display of copyrighted words and images. Guests are reminded that the use of any audio or video recording device is prohibited in support of U.S. copyright laws as well as distracting to other fans. Fans with still cameras are welcome to take photos for personal use.

Live-streaming: The Music Bowl will not be live-streamed this year.

Parking: There is limited parking for visitors on the campus grounds. We strongly recommend that guests car pool wherever possible. A large portion of the main (southwest) parking lot will be reserved for bus and equipment truck traffic. Handicapped parking is available in the District 99 Administration Building parking lot off of Springside. Additional parking is in neighborhoods south of 63rd Street. Concessions: We will have a full menu available including pizza, hot dogs, brats, burgers, snack items and beverages available throughout the day. The concession area will remain open all-day throughout the performances. Concessions are cash only please.

Non-Smoking Facility: The Downers Grove South Campus including all buildings and grounds has established a no-smoking policy at all times. Thank you for your cooperation.

First Aid: First Aid will be provided at the east entrance of the stadium by a qualified nurse.
